### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Of

### MINNESOTA TRANSPORTATION EDUCATION AND OUTREACH CENTER

The undersigned incorporators are individuals 18 years of age or older and adopt the following articles of incorporation to form a nonprofit corporation (Chapter 317A).

# ARTICLE I CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation shall be the Minnesota Transportation Education and Outreach Center.

# ARTICLE II **DURATION**

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

## ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The Minnesota Transportation Education and Outreach Center is a non-profit corporation that shall operate exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. The Minnesota Transportation Education and Outreach Center's purpose is to examine the effects of current and proposed transportation policies on communities, citizens, and related businesses, focusing on Minnesota but addressing other areas of the country as well. The Minnesota Transportation Education and Outreach Center serves interested citizens, governmental units and businesses in order to improve the quality of life in Minnesota and to encourage development of a safe, efficient and effective multi-modal transportation infrastructure appropriate to all areas of the state.

# ARTICLE IV NON-PROFIT NATURE

#### 4.01 Non-Profit Nature

The Minnesota Transportation Education and Outreach Center is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. No part of the net earnings of the Minnesota Transportation Education and Outreach Center shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, a corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or a corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Minnesota Education and Outreach Center is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the organization is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes.

### 4.02 Personal Liability

No officer or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of the Minnesota Education and Outreach Center of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

#### 4.03 Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of the Minnesota Education and Outreach Center, any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed under applicable law to one or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

#### 4.04 Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings or properties of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III.

#### 4.05 Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the organization's activities shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distributing of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

## ARTICLE V MEMBERSHIP AND GOVERNANCE

The Minnesota Transportation Education and Outreach Center shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the corporation's bylaws. The initial members of the Board of Directors are:
